Bids must be placed in the Tender Box situated at the Supply Chain Offices, Municipal Building, c/o of du Preez and H F Verwoerd Street, Heidelberg, on or before **12:00 on 26 March 2018**. The tender box is accessible during office hours, Mondays – Fridays, 08h30 – 16h00. No late, no e-mailed or nor faxed bids will be considered.

Bidder's attention is specifically drawn to the provisions of the rules which are included in the bid documents. The Council reserves the right to accept any bid or part thereof and does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any bid and not to consider any bid not suitably endorsed or comprehensively completed. Bids completed in pencil will be regarded as invalid bids.

Only bidders who score 60 points or more for functionality will be further evaluated on both Price and B-BBEE points.

The 80/20 preference procurement point system will apply and preference will be given to bidders who are able to demonstrate the following:

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| a) Price | 80 points |
| b) B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution | 20 points |

All service providers must submit their B-BBEE Verification Certificate from Verification Agencies accredited by the South African Accreditation Systems (SANAS) or a Registered Auditor approved by the Independent Regulatory Board (IRBA) or an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the Close Corporation Act (CCA) in order to claim preference points.

It is compulsory that the taxes of the successful bidder must be in order or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the bidder's tax obligations. Additionally, no contract shall be concluded with any bidder, whose municipal rates and taxes and service charges are in arrears for more than three months. All bidders must ensure that they are registered on the National Treasury Central Supplier Database via the following link:business.support@csd.gov.za. No business will be conducted with any person who is not registered on this database.
