3. Organizers will be required to comply with any conditions imposed by the Municipality.
4. Tariffs will be paid prior to confirmation of the bookings;
5. All tariffs shall include the additional (1) set up day and (1) breakdown day tariff;
6. The organizers will be required to apply to the Manager Safety & Rescue of the Municipality at least 30 days prior to the event in terms of the event categorization in terms of Safety in Sport Event, Act 2010
7. All bookings are subject to the payment of a “Damage Deposit” regardless of any other concessions made. The “Damage Deposit” may be used to recover the costs for repairing damages to the facility or cleaning the site. The deposit will only be refunded after the site has been cleared and inspection of the facility has been undertaken by the relevant officials and no damage identified;
8. The Lesedi Local Municipality reserves the right to cancel or stop the event if the organizers does not comply with any of the stipulated conditions; or for whatever reason it deems necessary. In such an eventuality the event organizers will have no claim against the Municipality.
