Tender documents can also be downloaded for free on the E-Tender portal ([www.etenders.gov.za](http://www.etenders.gov.za)). Only tenderers with a CIDB grading of 3EP or higher are eligible to submit tenders. A compulsory briefing session will be held on 20 April 2018 at Jameson Park Substation (C/o McLennan Drive and Smit Street, Jameson Park) at 12h00.

The bid must be sealed in an envelope marked: **TENDER NO: 21/2018: TENDER FOR THE RE-CONDITIONING OF THE SWITCHING STATION AND FITTING OF SWITCHGEAR AT JAMESON PARK SUBSTATION.** Bids must be placed in the Tender Box situated at the Supply Chain Management Department, Municipal Building, c/o of Du Preez and H F Verwoerd Street, Heidelberg, on or before 12:00 on the 07th of May 2018, and will be opened in public. Tender Box will be open during office hours Monday – Friday, 07:30 – 15:30. **No e-mailed or faxed bids will be considered.**

Bidder's attention is specifically drawn to the provisions of the rules which are included in the bid documents. The Council reserves the right to accept any bid or part thereof and does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any bid and not to consider any bid not suitably endorsed or comprehensively completed. Bids completed in pencil will be regarded as invalid bids.

The 80/20 preference procurement point system will apply and preference will be given to bidders who are able to demonstrate the following:

All service providers must submit their B-BBEE Verification Certificate from Verification Agencies accredited by the South African Accreditation Systems (SANAS) or a Registered Auditor approved by the Independent Regulatory Board (IRBA) or an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the Close Corporation Act (CCA) in order to claim preference points.

It is compulsory that the taxes of the successful bidder must be in order or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the bidder's tax obligations. Additionally, no contract shall be concluded with any bidder, whose municipal rates and taxes and service charges are in arrears for more than three months. No business will be conducted with any person who is not registered on this database.
