It is estimated that tenderers should have a cidb contractor grading of 5CE. 4CE Potentially Emerging Enterprises who satisfy criteria stated in the tender data may submit tender offers.

Preferences are offered to contractors who have a 5CE or 4CE PE CIDB Grading or higher. A CRS number should be stated on the bid document.

Only contractors who have a 5CE or 4CE PE CIDB Grading or higher are eligible to submit tenders.

Documents may be collected during working hours after 10h00 on 2016/05/03 from the Supply Chain Offices. A non-refundable tender deposit of R1, 696.00 payable by proof of deposit or cash is required on collection of the tender documents.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at Service Delivery Boardroom on 2016/05/04 starting at 10h00.

The completed proposals must be submitted in a sealed envelope marked "Functionality". The completed tender document must be submitted in a separate sealed envelope clearly marked "Price". Both envelopes must be placed in one single sealed envelope marked:- **TENDER NO: 03/2016: RESEALING OF ROADS IN LESEDI**

Tenders are to be completed in black ink and completed in accordance with the conditions and rules contained in the tender documents. Tenders and relevant documents must be deposited in the tender box situated at the Development and Planning Department, Municipal Building, 1 HF Verwoerd St, Civic Centre Building, Heidelberg, 1441 not later than 12h00 on 12 May 2016. Tenders will immediately be opened in public. Tenders shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the closing date. Tenders will be evaluated in terms of the Supply Chain Management policy of the Lesedi Local Municipality.

The LLM (Lesedi Local Municipality) reserves the right not to accept the lowest priced proposal or any proposal in part or in whole. It normally awards the contract to the tenderer who proves to be fully capable of handling the contract and whose proposal is technically acceptable, has meaningful empowerment credentials and / or financially advantageous to the LLM. LLM reserves the right to negotiate rates, for purposes of creating uniformity and the tenderer, by responding to this tender, agrees to abide by such negotiated rate which may be changed from time to time by agreement between the parties. Any bid not suitably endorsed or comprehensively completed, as well as bids completed in pencil will be regarded as invalid bids. **All objections and complaints must be lodged within 14 days and in writing to the municipal's manager's office.**

Only bidders who score 65% or more for functionality will be further evaluated on both Price and B-BBEE points.

The 90/10 preference procurement point system will apply and preference will be given to bidders who are able to demonstrate the following:-

NB: All service providers must submit their B-BBEE Verification Certificate from Verification Agency accredited by the South African Accreditation Systems (SANAS) or Registered Auditor approved by the Independent Regulatory Board (IRBA) or an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the Close Corporation Act (CCA) in order to claim preference points.

It is a condition of bid that the taxes of the successful bidder must be in order, or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the bidder's tax obligations. Tenderers should submit an Original SARS Tax Clearance Certificate. Additionally, no contract shall be concluded with any bidder, whose municipal rates and taxes and service charges are in arrears.
